Pre-Event Tours

21 April 2022 Tour 1: National Stud & Powerscourt Estate Distillery 08:00-18:00 | €225 (min. 25, max. 40 persons)

Tour the Irish National Stud and its Japanese Gardens, a unique attraction of outstanding natural beauty that is home to some of the most magnificent horses and exquisite gardens to be found anywhere in the world. Drive through Wicklow, the "Garden of Ireland", to the historic Powerscourt Estate, for a tour of the sumptuous gardens (voted third best in the world by National Geographic) and a tour and tasting in the Irish Whiskey distillery in the Estate's 18th Century Mill House.

22 April 2022 Tour 2: Glendalough 08:00-13:00 | €125 (max. 40 persons)

Explore Glendalough Monastic Site, founded in the sixth century by St Kevin and a source of learning and spiritual contemplation for centuries. Walk the ruins; immerse yourself in its rich history, including the impressive Round Tower used to withstand Viking attacks, the Cathedral, iconic churches and buildings; and marvel at the surrounding natural beauty of Glendalough, the "valley of two lakes".

Transportation

Participants are responsible for taking care of their own flight reservations and for arranging transportation from their point of arrival in Ireland (e.g. Dublin Airport) to their hotel, as well as for their return trip, departing from the hotel.

Dublin Airport is an international airport located 7km north of Dublin. Taxis are readily available as well as a number of buses which travel to the city centre. You may also arrange a transfer with your selected hotel subject to a supplement.

During the event, all transportation will be provided.

To remain compliant with Irish health protocols, please note that proof of full COVID-19 vaccination will be required to attend all parts of the event programme. We will continue to monitor the situation, update and communicate our related guidance accordingly.
