


# The Honours Programme




### How your contribution makes a difference

When the global corona pandemic hit, Kim Robert saw first-hand the severe negative impact on low-income families. Enter SALAD (Scouts Aid for Low-income and Distressed), a unique, gravity-defying, vertical urban gardening project to promote healthy and sustainable food sources and assist more Scouts and the community by providing food relief packs for families in need. *"Through this initiative we have a sustainable way of helping fellow citizens."* 



#### **Mykyta Rohutskyi** Ukraine

When war broke out in Ukraine, Mykyta supported his community by providing food and activities for children impacted by the war. At day camps, he offered games, outdoor activities, and support to improve the physical and mental health of young people in Kyiv, one of the most affected cities affected by the war. Mykyta was named as a "Messengers of Peace Hero" in 2022.



#### **Nadine Shili** Tunisia

As a Youth Representative for World Scouting, Nadine Shili champions raising the voices of young people around the world. Thanks to the skills of teamwork and leadership that she gained in Scouting in her home country of Tunisia, Nadine now advocates for the right to quality education in Global Forums with such as the Transforming Education Summit.
